If your grandchild or any other "family member" calls and asks you to wire money IMMEDIATELY because they are in trouble, it's probably a scam. With voice cloning on the rise, it's best to have a **safe word** only your family knows to verify it's really them.

### A NEW MEDICARE CARD ON THE WAY?

No official organization will call you and ask for your Medicare/Medicaid ID or any personal information.
